## **Essay Topic Description and Requirements**

  innovative ideas to make our roads safer. Let's work together to prevent distracted driving and save
  lives.

#### Instructions

All applications, transcripts, and essays MUST be mailed or emailed to kellan@elrodpope.com in a single package. Items sent separately or in any other form will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Scholarships are judged and awarded without regard to race, gender, color, religion, creed, national origin, disability or sexual orientation.

#### **Eligibility and Criteria**

Must be a current high school senior or student at a college or university. Must live in either North Carolina or South Carolina. Must be accepted for full time enrollment or planning to pursue a degree at an accredited college or university.

#### **Deadline to Apply**

All entries must be postmarked or timestamped on or before Monday, April 28, 2025. Elrod Pope Accident and Injury Attorneys are not responsible for any late, lost, or damaged entries.

#### **Entering Your Application**

Applicants must provide the following items in a single submission to qualify for consideration:

- Scholarship application (typed or neatly printed) and a recent photo of yourself.
- An 1,000 word essay that highlights all the required topics detailed below
- Official or unofficial high school transcript (must include class rank and size).

#### **Submissions and Essays**

Each year, thousands of young drivers between the ages of 15 and 22 are involved in serious motor vehicle crashes due to distracted driving. Whether it's texting, using social media, eating, or adjusting in-car entertainment, distractions take attention away from the road—often with devastating consequences. In the United States, distracted driving contributes to a significant number of injuries and fatalities, leading to billions of dollars in medical costs and lost productivity annually.

The Elrod Pope Accident and Injury Attorneys Focus Forward Scholarship aims to raise awareness and promote safer driving habits among young adults by encouraging creative and impactful peer-to-peer messaging. While the dangers of distracted driving remain constant, the ways in which we communicate and inspire change evolve over time. We challenge students to develop compelling and innovative ways to influence their peers to stay focused behind the wheel.

#### **Selection of Winners**

A panel of judges from the Elrod Pope Law Firm will select 2 winners for the Focus Forward Scholarship. The selection process will be based on several factors, including academic performance, involvement in school and community activities, and the quality of the essay. Essays will be evaluated on the student's ability to analyze, discuss, and effectively communicate the dangers of distracted driving. The judges' decisions are final. Scholarship recipients will be notified by phone, while applicants who are not selected will receive an email notification. Submissions will be disqualified if they contain inappropriate or offensive content, fail to include all required documentation, use copyrighted materials without proper permission, or lack proper citations for sourced content.



#### **Number of Awards**

Two winners will each receive a \$5,000 scholarship to the college/ university of their choice. Odds of winning a prize depends on the number of entries received.

#### **Method of Scholarship Disbursement**

Awards are paid in one installment. Scholarship checks are made out to both the student and the 4-year College or accredited institution.

#### **Ownership of Scholarship Entries**

All entries submitted to the Elrod Pope Accident and Injuries Attorneys in connection with the scholarship, along with all copyright, trademark and other proprietary rights associated therewith, become the property of the Elrod Pope Accident and Injuries Attorneys upon submission.
